Students enrolled in the General Arts and Science Certificate Program work closely with an Educational Planner who helps them to select five required course options, along with a minimum of nine elective courses. Elective courses can be General Education courses, or courses considered "core" to other programs. This flexibility allows students to explore a variety of learning opportunities, all arranged within a highly individualized timetable designed to meet their specific interests and needs. If you're looking to gain experience and confidence studying at the college level while also exploring potential programs and career options, this certificate could be perfect for you. If you decide to continue on in an additional postsecondary certificate or diploma program, it is possible to transfer courses that you've completed in GAPG over to your new program (discuss specific details with the Educational Planner or Program Coordinator).
